

Eligibility Criteria

Minimum Academic Qualifications for B.Arch:

- 10+2 or equivalent from a recognized Board/University with Mathematics as subjects of examination and also obtained 50% aggregate marks in 10+2 level examination. (OR) Candidates with 10+3 Diploma (any stream) recognized by central / State Governments with mathematics as compulsory subject and obtained with 50% in aggregate marks. (OR) International Baccalaureate Diploma, after 10 years of schooling, with not less than 50% marks in aggregate and with Mathematics as compulsory subject of Examination.
- Merit list shall be based on aggregate marks of 10+2 and valid NATA score (percentage) or score (percentage) of qualified JEE (Main) Paper-2 -2017 (B. Arch./B.Planning) in the ratio 50:50.
- The candidate must have passed NATA with valid NATA Score as per COA.
- Obtained at least 50% marks (47.5% in case of candidate belonging to SC category) in the qualifying Examination.
